

3D Flower Power

For Machine Embroiderers who want to try something different. The 3D flowers are from Sarah Vedeler's 3D collection. There are two design set choices, 3Dmaxi or 3Dmini. Both come with flowers that can be stitched as standalone designs or added to the included vases.

3DMaxi Comes contains both the Maxi and Mini design sets which have multiple vase types and 6 different flower sized. The 3DMini only has the smaller flower sizes (4", 4.5" & 5")and a smaller vase. See both at the following url

pls note: we will spend the first half of the class making a stand-alone flower. For those of you who wish to do the complete wall hanging, I will go over how to setup the wall hanging design in the second half of the class.

OPTIONS:

For **stand-alone flowers**, use wash-away stabilizer—i use two layers of Pellon "Wash-N-Gone". You will also need fabric for the flower body, petals and flower center. Use separate fabrics for the base, petal tops, and petal bottoms. The center requires two 2x2-inch pieces of batting and a 3x3-inch piece of fabric.

For flower stitching in the Vedler **wall design**, use a battilizer or tear-away stabilizer and batting. Gather background and vase fabrics as listed in the downloaded instructions.
